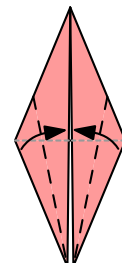
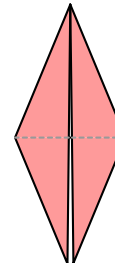
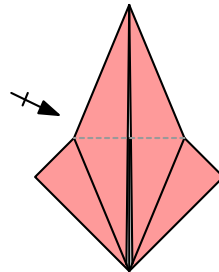
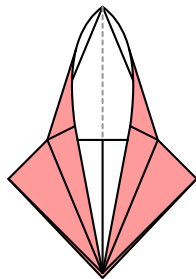
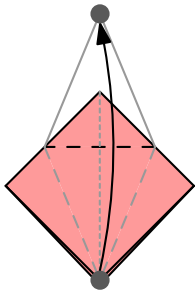
2) Retourner la feuille

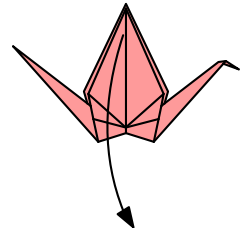
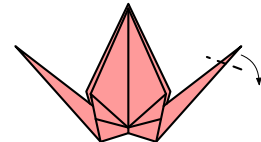
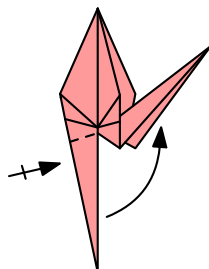
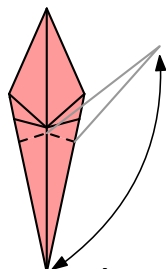
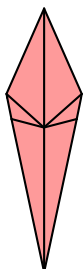
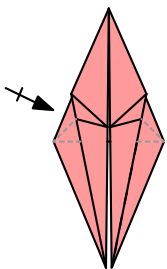
5) marquer les plis selon les deux schémas ci-dessus
